

RENO SPAGHETTI BOWL

Phase 2A Design Modification

The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) is making a design modification to the Reno Spaghetti Bowl Project – Phase 2A. The design modification of Phase 2A realigns I-80 to the north, beginning east of SR 668 (Rock Boulevard), extending east for approximately 1/2 mile, and reconnecting to existing I-80 at SR 445 (Pyramid Way).

Phase 2 is the continuation of the Reno Spaghetti Bowl Project and is split into two subphases: Phase 2A (Rock Blvd to East McCarran Blvd) and Phase 2B (East of the Spaghetti Bowl to Rock Blvd).

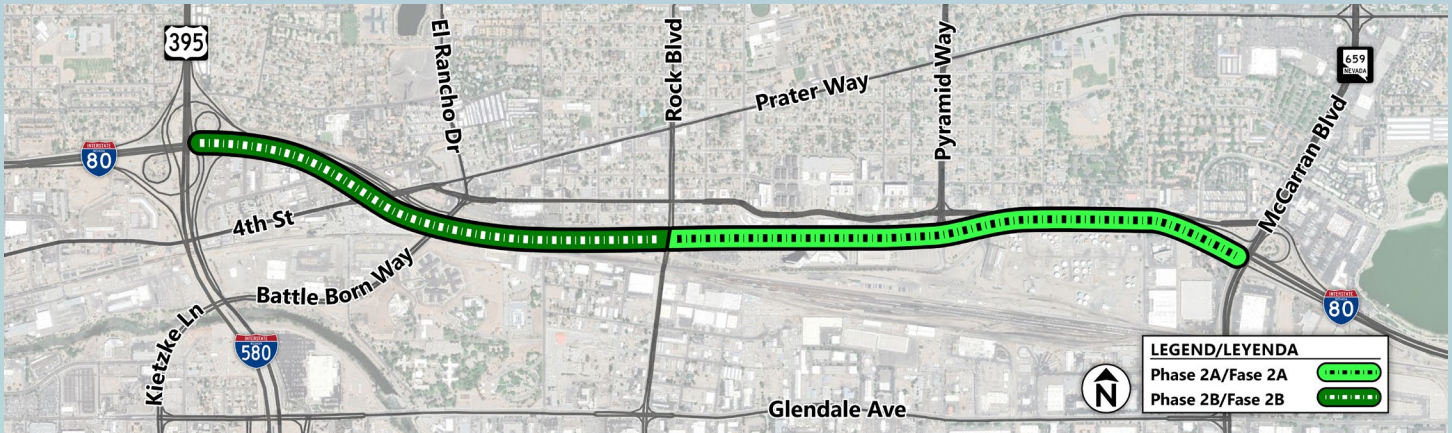
Purpose and Need

- Reduce travel delay
- Improve Safety
- Update bridge conditions and improve functionality
- Optimize system connections

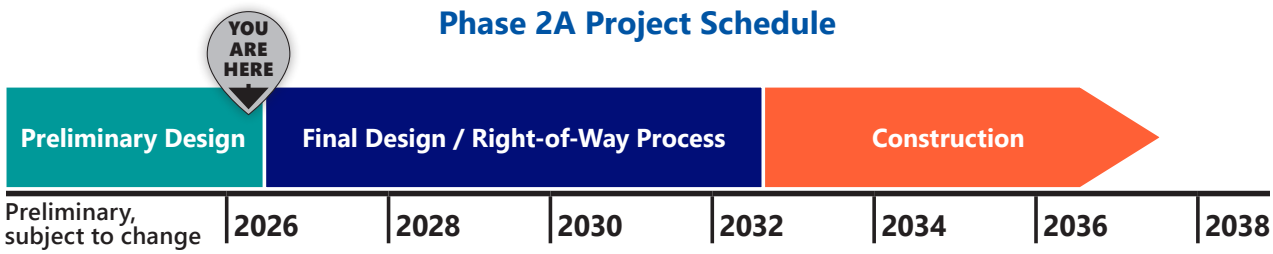
Phase 2A Improvements

- Widen I-80 from Rock Blvd to East McCarran Blvd
- Partial reconstruction of Rock Blvd interchange
- Reconstruction of Pyramid Way interchange
- Build a new I-80 viaduct bridge between Rock Blvd and Pyramid Way
